**CROW CREEK SANITARY SEWER REPAIR AND CROW CREEK STABILIZATION**

MSA accompanied Mr. Matthew Schmit, Dean of Operations for Scott Community College, on his site review of this project. It is MSA's understanding that Scott Community College finds the level of site restoration acceptable. Therefore, MSA is proceeding with closing out the project.

WOODS ESTATES ENGINEERING REVIEW

MSA has completed their second review of the final plans for Addition 1. Review comments have been provided to j+m civil design. MSA observed site conditions on October 4. MSA will provide detail on this Field Report at the City Council meeting.

MSA is concerned about stabilizing the site for the upcoming late fall / winter season. Therefore, MSA, as directed by the City, is setting up a coordinating meeting with all involved parties.

PLEASANT VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL PARKING LOT CONSTRUCTION

The South Campus Parking Lot detention basin does not yet have established turf. In addition, IMEG contacted MSA and indicated the detention basin was not constructed with the volume required by City Ordinance. IMEG and MSA discussed possible ways to resolve this. We left off that IMEG is not requesting a variance. They will direct the modifications that are necessary to conform to the City Ordinance.

PROJECT UPDATE

JOINT SEWERAGE INITIATIVE CONSULTATION

MSA will continue to work with Council to select an appropriate level of inflow and infiltration investigation for the City's sanitary sewer system.

NPDES PERMIT ADMINISTRATION

The City is currently reviewing the draft copy of the MSA generated report. We respectfully request this be completed by next week so the report can be finalized and submitted to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources by the end of October.

REHABILITATION OF CITY ROADWAYS

MSA received the request from the City to make a recommendation to the City for prioritizing city financial assets in preparing a roadway program for the coming calendar year. MSA will prepare an informal recommendation for the October 23 City Council meeting.
